



Dear Parent or Guardian,

The Healthy Schools Act of 2000 (as amended by Assembly Bill 2865, Chapter 865, Statutes of 2006) requires all California school districts and child day care centers to notify parents and guardians of pesticides that they expect will be applied during the upcoming year.

We have a contract for a bi- monthly service in the outdoor areas. Pesticides may be applied on two Saturdays each month. A notice will be posted 72 hours before each treatment, and will remain posted for several days after the treatment. Our goal is to eliminate ants, roaches, mice, fleas, and rats.

The following pesticides may be used at the CSUF Children’s Center:
