- Only campaign to students in the academic college they are running for (Ex. HSS runs for the HSS positions).
- Opening statements at Elections Kickoff Event, time to engage with students with current BOD members at Candidate Coachella, more opening statements at Housing Debate/time to engage with residents from same academic college.
- Best suited for students with some student leadership experience.

Titan Student Centers Governing Board

- Nine (9) positions, only seven (7) up for election this year.
- May unofficially campaign together.
- Campaign to all 40,000+ students of CSUF.
- Opening statements at Elections Kickoff Event, time to engage with students with current TSC members at Candidate Coachella, more opening statements at Housing Debate/time to engage with residents.
- Good for students new to leadership!
