REPORTS

a. Chair

Evans reported the following:

- 1) ACUI was November 16-18, 2018.
- 2) Due to prior contractual agreements solar panels would not be installed on any buildings in the near future. Campus stated they would keep ASI in mind for future sustainability projects.
- 3) Reminded the committee that Rebecca Hesgard sent out information regarding roundtables sign ups. Hesgard would be looking for one BOT representative per roundtable.

Evans yielded to Borjas.

Borjas, can you explain why solar panels cannot be installed.

Jeff answered, the University has too much solar panels. The University has an agreement with Southern California Edison. The University is only able to provide a certain amount of solar required by Southern California Edison. Jeff stated that there are some days the solar panels contribution is turned off in order to avoid a penalty fee. The new parking structure would have solar panels due to the California State laws. ASI will be considered when the University is looking to add more panels.

b. Associate Director, Titan Student Union

Fehrn reported the following:

1) Look forward to ACUI.

c. Marketing Liaison/Trustee, TSCBOT

Vanderhook reported the following:

- 1) TSCBOT handbills and promotional items were submitted and should be delivered soon.
- 2) Working towards a Board of Trustees Instagram saved story.
- 3) Submitted order for water conservation SRC shower posters.
- 4) Signage for the battery collection box was submitted.

NEW BUSINESS

a. Action: TSU Club Office Space Allocation

FC 001 18/19 (M) Torres (S) Borjas moved to approve TSU Club office space allocation.

Yielded to Drew Wiley, Director, Leader & Program Development to elaborate on the TSU club office space allocation.

Wiley highlighted on the following:

- The clubs were ranked in an order fashion by score and the average score across all of the graders.
- Draft / recommend allocation layout of the club spaces.
- C 1 and C2 are two hall cubicles.
- The two groups with the best scoring will have the two individual cubicles.
- If one club withdraws the next club on the list would be considered for a club space.

Wiley stated the committee has the ability to move clubs around. The proposed club space were group based on similarity.

Evans moved to discuss their strategy on scoring the applications.

Evans moved into a roll call vote to approve the proposed office space allocation assignment as presented.

b. Action: TSC Capital Expenditures- 2019

FC 002 18/19 (M) Gill (S) Aguilar moved to approve TSC Capital Expenditures- 2019.

Evans yielded to Allen.

Allen explained the process of capital projects. The committee would approve the funds requested from various departments. This helps understand what the needs are in various departments.

Evans yielded to Fehrn.

Fehrn highlighted on the following TSC Capital Equipment:

- Brunswick Software/Hardware: University safety security software required to operate the Titan Bowling. The current software would not be compatible with the required University server update. If server & software are not updated they would not be useable.
- 2. TSU Courtyard Furniture: The central courtyard between the University Conference Center and the Food court patio furniture would be replaced to create a uniform look.
- TSU Pavilion Sound Upgrade: Looking to increase sound capacity and purchase new items. The upgrade would help the staff setup time and ability to provide professional sound.
- 4. TSU Telecomm Rack Upgrade: There are three telecomm closets that have systems that run the building. Funds would be used to upgrade the closets to be accessible, increase server space and racks in the closets to accommodate all the future projects.
- 5. TBB furniture: The funds would allow to purchase cohesive furniture.

Evan yielded to Aaron Tapper to highlight SRC capital equipment:

- Titan Recreation conference office furniture: Furniture would be purchased to replace the worn out furniture in the conference room and office chairs for staff.
- 2. Rockwall flooring replacement: Safety hazards due to ripped flooring would need to be repaired.
- SRC Scheduling Display Software/Hardware: Scheduling displays for studios and courts. Updates made to the schedule would reflect immediately on the scheduling displays.
- 4. Weight Room Equipment Replacement: The equipment needs to be updated. Has spent approximately \$10,000 repairing old equipment.

Fehrn highlighted on the following:

- The TSC Andover HVAC Control Software and Hardware: The HVAC control software and hardware controls the temperature in the Student Recreation Center and the Titan Student Union. Systems need to be updated in order to be compatible with the updates.
- 2. TSC Marketing IMacs: The Marketing department has grown since the last capital request. The purchase of additional IMacs would eliminate the limitations of students working on projects. The marketing department is sharing five computers between seventeen student employees.

Evans stated that the TSU food court furniture and flooring would be removed from the TSC capital expenditures to be on the agenda as an action item. Evans yielded to Duncan to elaborate.

Duncan stated it isn't something that needs to be done through capital request. The project would be done through a proposal. This would allow for all the information to be gathered and then allocate the funds.

Evans moved into questions.

Kurtz, how old is the furniture in the courtyard?

Fehrn, the tables have been there since 2000. New chairs were purchased in 2017.

Kurtz, the closet upgrades was this on last year's capital request?

Allen, the closet was expanded last year. There are safety issues and size that need to be upgraded.

Stephen Ramirez, IT Manager stated that one of the closest were updated last year. All three closest need to be done. Two closest need to be upgraded as soon as possible and the last one would be completed till after the expansion. Ramirez clarified that the TSU telecomm rack upgrade would be completed before working hours to avoid interruptions.

Evans yielded to Kurtz.

Kurtz, what is the lifespan of the new Rockwall flooring replacement?

Tapper, it has a 10 year warranty.

Evans, if IMacs are granted would all the computers in the Marketing department be IMacs?

Martin, yes all work stations would have IMacs.

Vanderhook, how many students are scheduled to work during the same shift? What is the need for more IMacs?

Martin, all the designers and videographers use IMacs. Having five IMacs in the marketing departments limits the students ability to complete project quickly.

Evans, what happens to the old equipment?

Tapper, the old equipment would be returned and the company would credit ASI for it.

Tapper clarified that the new machines would be ordered through a new company that is used by the chancellor's office.

Evans moved into discussion.

Duncan stated he agreed with all the changes because they are due for an upgrade.

The committee expressed their concerns towards the capital request.

Evans moved to a roll call to approve the TSC capital expenditures for 2019. FC 002 18/19, motion passed 5-0-0

BACKGROUND

The Titan Student Union offers a club space program within the facility for recognized CSUF student clubs and organizations that includes office spaces and storage lockers. Office spaces are allocated by the TSCBOT each semester.

PROPOSAL

Allocate available club office spaces in the Titan Student Union to the recognized student organizations listed on the attached allocation roster for the Spring 2019 Semester.

RATIONALE

Based on the applications for office space submitted, the student organizations listed on the attached roster were assessed to have the best presented applications and plans for using the office space during the Spring Semester.

IMPACT

By offering space to recognized student organizations, the Titan Student Union continues to present opportunities for these organizations to engage with members and prospective members to accomplish club goals. As these spaces are already allocated for student organizations there will be no additional impact.

BUDGET IMPACT

There is no budget impact associated with the proposal.

BACKGROUND

As directed by California Education Code, CSU Chancellor's Office Executive Order, and System-wide Revenue Bond Requirements, ASI is required to maintain and reinvest in Titan Student Union and Student Recreation Center facilities and equipment. Annually, the Titan Student Center Board of Trustees utilizes existing reserve funds for this reinvestment.

ASI management proposes allocation of \$700,000 from the Titan Student Centers reserve funds for the projects outlined in the attached proposals.

PROPOSAL

Proposal to allocate \$700,000 from the Titan Student Centers reserve funds for the projects outlined in the attached proposals.

RATIONALE

Reinvestment in Titan Student Union and Student Recreation Center equipment and facilities improves services and programs for the CSUF student body, increases facility use and flexibility, and addresses appearance and safety issues within ASI facilities.

IMPACT

Impact on students, programs and services varies by item. Information is contained on the cover sheet for each item.

BUDGET IMPACT

There will be no operational impact. Expenditures will be funded from Titan Student Center reserves intended for repairs, equipment and maintenance.

IMPLEMENTATION TIMELINE

Approved purchases and projects will be completed during the 2019 calendar year.
