## 8. New Business

## a. Action: 2022-23 Operating Fees SRC & TSU

The Committee will consider approving the 2022-23 Operating Fees for the Student Recreation Center and the Titan Student Union.

FIN 005 21-22 (San Gabriel-m/Arnwine-s) A motion was made and seconded to approve the resolution to establish the 2022-23 operating fees for the Student Recreation Center and the

# resolution to establish the operating fees for the Titan Student Union.

Carlsen yielded to Nettles to review the resolution documents and fee schedule.

Nettles shared that management is recommending no changes to the operating fee schedule for the coming year for either facility. Nettles reviewed the schedules.

Nettles yielded to Aaron Tapper.

- Carlsen asked, when the pool deck is rented for an event, are others who are not a part of the event still allowed to enter the pool area?
   Tapper answered, yes. The facilities remain available and accessible to all students.
- Carlsen asked, what then is the difference in price between renting the deck and pool versus pool only? Tapper answered, the deck is not rented. Only the pool is rented.
- Carlsen asked, when renting courts, do renters need to plan the rental around planned sports events? Tapper answered, planned sports events on the courts take priority. Any open time not taken by a planned sports event is for rent.
- Carlsen asked, can students rent the conference room upstairs? Tapper answered, students can reserve the conference room. They don't need to rent it. Several clubs on campus reserve and use the conference room for their weekly meetings.
- Arnwine asked, when a student rents a court, does the open-and-accessible rule apply similar to the pools? Tapper answered, students who rent one court will have exclusive access to the court rented. Rarely are all three courts rented out in an attempt to maintain one open-and-accessible court.
- Arnwine asked, are the pool and deck area the only non-exclusive rentals? Tapper answered, rentals for certain facilities will be planned during non-open hours to limit the number of persons attending.
- Carlsen asked, can students plan their own sports events by renting courts and using referees and officials associated with campus planned events? Tapper answered, yes. Students can also provide their own officials.

Carlsen opened the floor to discussion. There was no discussion.

Carlsen asked if there were any objections to moving to a roll call vote. There were no objections.

Decision: FIN 005 21-22 Roll Call Vote: 3-0-0 The motion to approve a resolution to establish the 2022-23 operating fees for the Student Recreation Center and a resolution to establish the 2022-23 operating fees for the Titan Student Union was adopted.

#### **Room Rental Fees Philosophy**

- CSUF registered student organizations
  - Already "paid the cost" for TSU services through their student fees
  - No room rental charge
  - Direct costs are passed on to the group; e.g. building managers, etc.
  - Events sponsored by the alumni association included in this category

#### CSUF departments/on-campus groups

- Our goal is to recover, as close as possible, the actual total cost for the TSU to support the event
- Baseline for rate structure

#### Student/staff personal use and Extended Education courses

Rates are set between on-campus sponsored events and off-campus sponsored events

## Off-campus groups

No direct affiliation with CSUF

## Wedding, Quinceanera, and bar/bat mitzvah

- Require special attention and more staff resources
- Higher rate than regular off-campus sponsored events

## Commercial filming

- Category adopted in 2003
- Accommodates for higher staff and resources costs necessary for these types of projects
- Hourly charge
