Age Group: Toddler and Preschool

Stitching A Spider Web

Supplies needed:

A paper plate

Hole puncher

Yarn

Tape

Procedure: Cut out the middle of
the paper plate.

Punch holes around the inner edge
of the paper plate.

Cut a piece of yarn about 24 inches
long. Place tape on the end of the
yarn to become like a "needle".

Tie yarn through one hole in the
paper plate.

Give the child the end of the yard
with the tape so he/she can begin to
make a web by stitching from hole to
hole!



This activity helps the child to manipulate objects,
using hands with strength, accuracy, and coordination.

* We provide the children with a small plastic spider
to attach when they are finished!
