Activity Share: Ant Science Experiment

Age group: Preschool

## Materials Needed:

- A plate with four sections (you can draw out the sections or mark with tape).
- a piece of fruit or something sweet
- a piece of bread, a cracker, or a chip
- two other food scraps that you want to test!

## Directions:

- 1. Place the food on the plate.
- 2. Put the plate outside. Check it periodically for ants.
- 3. Observe the ants on the plate. What were the ants attracted to? Why do you think they like some foods but not others?

Use the scientific method to help guide your experiment!

## SCIENTIFIC METHOD



ASK A QUESTION

What do you want to know?



MAKE A HYPOTHESIS

What do you think will happen?



EXPERIMENT

Test what you want to know and conduct your experiment.



**OBSERVE** 

What do you notice is happening?



ANALYZE

Why do you think that is happening?



DISCUSS

Talk to a friend or a grown up about what you have learned.
