DRDP Measure: Classification

Age Group: Toddler

Color Sort/Hunt

You can help your child develop classification skills by comparing and contrasting the attributes of items.

Talk about what makes the items similar and what makes them different.

This activity can be done in multiple ways.

- Have child gather all the toys they want to sort.
- Have child go find all the brown toys, then all the red, then the yellow, etc.
- Have child pick one toy at a time and sort it as they go.



Materials: Colored Construction Paper, a variety of colored toys



Step 1: Place construction paper on the floor or table



Step2: Gather a variety of colored toys



Step 3: Have your child sort toys onto colored construction paper
