DRDP Measure: Communication and Use of Language (Expressive)

Age Group: Toddlers

What's in the Bag?

This activity encourages children to build on their vocabulary by using single words to name objects and later by putting two words together to describe the object.



Materials:

Bag (or pillowcase)

About 10 familiar objects (toys or household items)

1

Place objects in the bag

2

Present bag to child by holding it and giving it a little shake saying, "I wonder what's inside the bag?"

3

Take turns taking out an object from the bag. Name the object and use it for its purpose. (ex. Blue hairbrush-brush hair; yellow car-push along floor saying "vroom or beep")
