Puddle Jumping Alphabet Activity

Developmental information:

Letter and Word Knowledge

Child shows increasing awareness of letters in the environment and their relationship to sound, including understanding that letters make up words



Materials Needed:

- Blue paper
- Scissors
- Black marker
- Painter's tape
- Music



Setting Up the Puddle Jumping Letter Alphabet Activity:

- 1. Cut the blue paper into puddle-like shapes. Make one puddle per sheet of paper.
- 2. Write a letter on each puddle.
- 3. Make tape loops and place one on the back of each puddle.
- 4. Stick your puddles to the ground in a circle.
- 5. Playing the Puddle Jumping Letter Sounds Alphabet Game
- 6. Once you start playing the music start jumping from puddle to puddle until the music stopped.
- 7. When the music stopped he should stop too.
- 8. Identified the letter your child stopped on by name and then by sound.
