## Five Green and Speckled Frogs

This activity encourages children to participate in singing songs with an adult from beginning to end.


## Materials:

- Paper Towel Tube
- Construction Paper (brown, blue)
- Frog Printable (see following slide)
- Stapler, glue, scissors

## **Directions:**

- Print, color and cut out frogs
- Cut out a wavy piece of blue construction paper and attach onto brown construction paper then cut into two inch strips
- Wrap strips around paper towel tube and staple as closely as possible but allowing strip to move up and down
- Glue frogs onto each strip to look like they are sitting on the log (blue construction paper should be on opposite side of frogs)
- Draw some bugs and details on log
- Sing the song with your child and as each frog jumps into the pool, flip down the frog
