## Color Mixing Sensory Bag



## Materials:

Quart or gallon size Ziplock bag
Packing or Duct Tape
Paint (red, yellow, blue)
Shaving cream (optional)

## Directions:

Fill ziplock bag with shaving cream
Add two paint colors on opposite ends of bag Close bag and secure with tape
You can make several bags with different color combinations
Have your child explore the sensory bag and mix the paint together.
Help your child make observations by asking open-ended questions such as:

How does it feel?
What do you see?
What are the colors doing?
Do you see something new?
You can also compare the different bags of color mixtures Read the book White Rabbit's Color Book to help extend and make a connection to the activity. (click on book for read along)
