Activity Share: Ice Puck Painting

Age group: Infants, Toddlers and Preschool

Materials Needed:

- Silicon muffin tins or small round plastic container
- Tempera paint
- A large cardboard box (carefully cut off the flaps if needed)
- Large pieces of paper
- Water

Directions:

- Fill muffin tins or container with water and freeze to make ice pucks
- 2. Line the bottom of the cardboard box with paper and then drop small amounts of paint onto the paper.
- 3. Place one or two ice pucks onto the paper.
- 4. Help your child tilt the sides of the box to have the ice pucks glide over the paint and paper to make your painting. Hang up painting to dry and enjoy!

Talk to your child about the colors they are using, the textures they feel, the coldness of the ice, etc.
