VII. **Reports**

a. **Elections Director**

Khai Hoang, Elections Judicial Council Chair, shared that we are moving into the final week of the Elections process. There is one additional main event leading up to the vote. There will be one more confirmed EJC meeting, next Thursday if there are any considerations.

IX. **New Business**

a. **ASI Elections Complaint #002 & #004**

The Elections Judicial Council will consider ASI Elections Complaint #2 & #4

EJC 002 19/20 (Garcia-m/Halisi-s) A motion was made and seconded to approve ASI Elections Complaint #2 and ASI Elections Complaint #4 as a violation.

Hoang invited complainants to the podium to present complaint number 2 and number 4. None of the complainants were present. According to the policy regarding considering complaints the complainants must be present to present the complaint. If the parties are not present the complaint is not considered.

Hoang opened the floor to questions.

Halisi asked about the stamp on the form and if that would confirm the complaint was invalid.

Wiley confirmed that since there were no parties present the complaint would not be considered by the EJC.

Hoang asked if there were any objections to closing the complaint. There were no objections.

Kurtz arrived during roll call vote.

Decision: EJC 002 19/20 (Garcia-m/Halisi-s) Roll Call Vote: 5-0-1 ASI Elections Complaint #002 was closed.

b. ASI Elections Complaint #003

The Elections Judicial Council will consider ASI Elections Complaint #3

EJC 003 19/20 (Garcia-m/Aguirre-s) A motion was made and seconded to approve ASI Elections Complaint #3 as a violation.

Hoang invited Tristan Torres, complainant to the podium to present complaint #3.

Torres informed the Council that he found an online flyer promoting two candidates running and campaigning together which is a violation of ASI Elections Policy.

The candidates were invited to the podium to speak to the complaint. The candidates indicated that they thought that they could campaign on the same team. They asked an Elections Coordinator who confirmed they could. Once they were informed it was a violation, they removed the pictures.

Hoang opened the floor to questions. There were no questions.

Hoang opened the floor to discussion.

Halisi shared she was at fault for giving incorrect information when asked about two candidates posting a flyer together online. She shared that she learned at the first EJC meeting that questions should be referred to the RFI form which is available online. All subsequent questions are now referred accordingly.

Kurtz shared the issue is pretty straight forward and based on the situation the action was a Class B violation.

Aguirre shared that she understands miscommunication, however in this instance there clearly was a violation.

Decision: EJC 003 19/20 (Garcia-m/Aguirre-s) Roll Call Vote: 4-1-1 ASI Elections Complaint #003 was confirmed.

Aguirre asked all to sign up as a spring concert volunteer and to support the event.





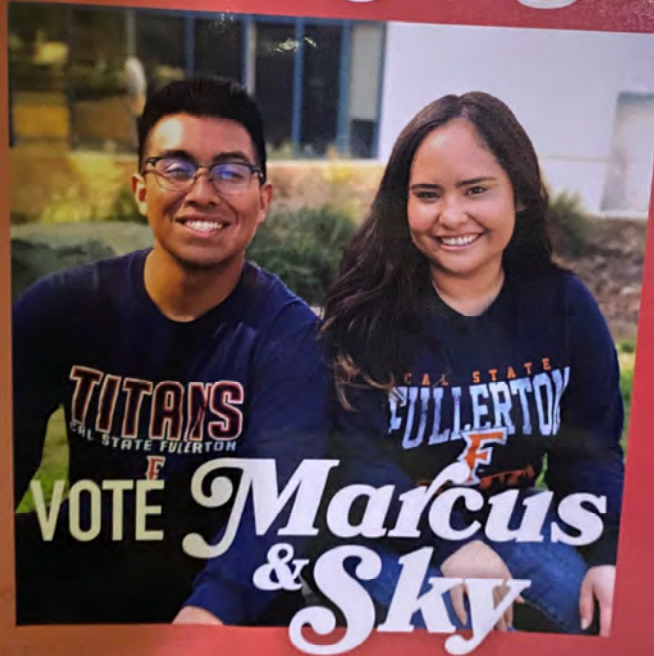

As I walked through the campus today (3-1-20), I saw advertisements for "Marcus and Sky" for ASI president and Vice Present without a stamp of approval from SLL. I don't think it is fair that they are able to post these up while other clubs don't get to or get their flyers taken down. Just because they are going for ASI president and vp does not make them more special or have more privileges. As I went to check the elections policy, under violation C it said to turn to SLL posting policy for elections and it stated

on SLL site that anything not stamped will be taken down. And that anything posted needed approval prior. Attached is the photo of the candidates along with the policies.

c. Class C (Minor) Violations

Class C (Minor) Violations shall carry one (1) strike. If a candidate commits any of the following the candidate will acquire one (1) strike against their campaign, and the official ballot shall reflect the specific violation and circumstance:

- A violation of these Bylaws, ASI Policy, CSU Fullerton Policy, State or Federal Law in connection to the election in a way which minimally affects the outcome or integrity of the electoral or judicial processes.
- Using CSU Fullerton or ASI authority, facilities, funds, or resources that are not open to all students for campaign purposes to an extent which minimally affects the outcome or integrity of the election.
- Violating the CSU Fullerton Posting Policy. Refer to Student Life and Leadership for more information.

Note: Any flyers found posted lacking the appropriate stamp or found posted in an unapproved location will be removed immediately. Individuals or organizations found posting in an unapproved location or without proper stamping will be considered in violation of the CSUF Posting Policy.
