a. Discussion: Overview of Student Programs and Engagement

b. Discussion: Student Recreation Center- Intramurals

The Committee will discuss post-Covid participation and the participation of women at the SRC.

Keith Hernandez, SRC Operations Coordinator shared a presentation on SRC Program Engagement in Intramurals. Data shows 16-22% female participation in intramural sports from Fall 2021-Spring 2023.

Ong opened the floor to questions. There were none.

c. Discussion: Student Recreation Center- Drop-In Fitness Classes

The Committee will discuss the usage of SRC facilties by women and by beginners.

The presentation included statistics on student drop-in classes.

From Fall 2021 to Spring 2023 female participation in drop-in fitness classes ranged from 84%-91%. In the summer, the percentage decreased to 48%-55%.

Ong opened the floor to questions.

Ong asked what the attendance rate is per class. Hernandez, responded that attendance is 21-25 attendees. Ong, asked if the classes at the SRC are at capacity. Hernandez responded that classes are not filled to capacity.
