

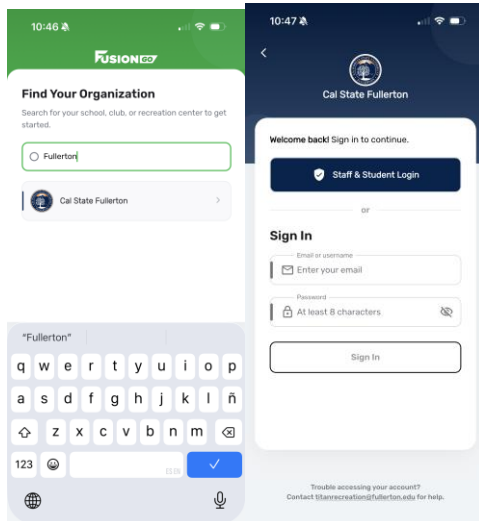
INTRAMURAL SPORTS REGISTRATION

FIRST: Activate your SRC Membership

Step 1: Download the Fusion Go App. This is the new app for accessing the Student Recreation Center.

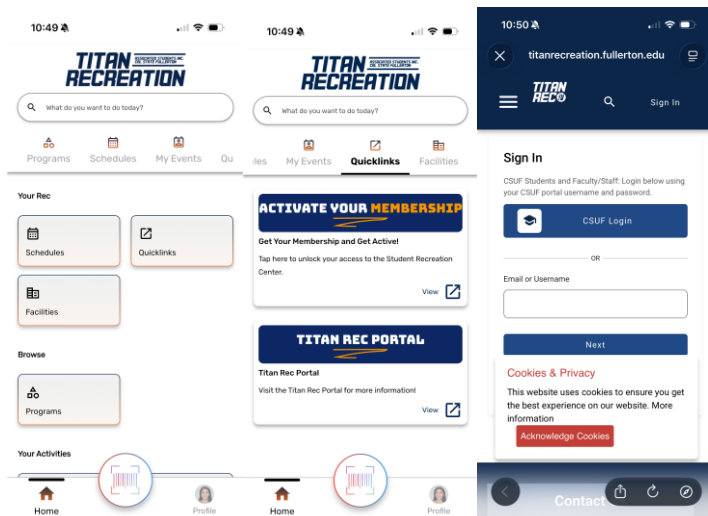
Step 1.1: Enter and select Cal State Fullerton as your organization.

Step 1.2: Select “Staff & Student Login” and use your CSUF credentials to login.



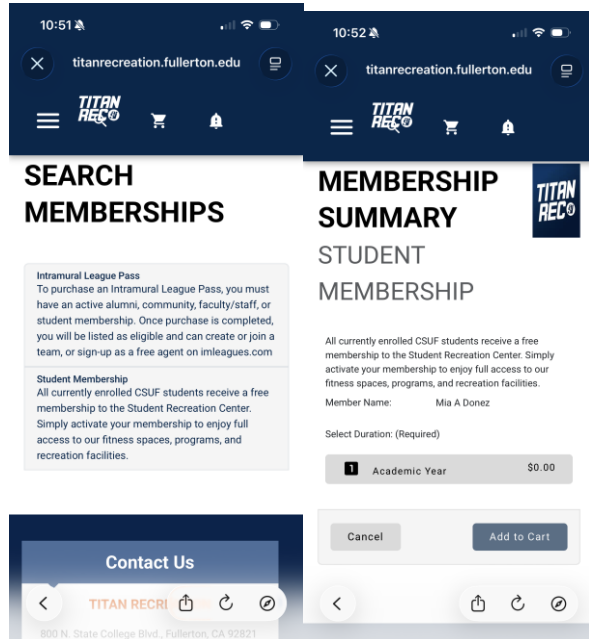
Step 2: Activate your student membership by clicking “Quicklinks”. Click on “Activate Your Membership”

*This will take you the Titan Recreation website, where you will login with your CSUF Credentials.



Step 2.1: First activate your student membership by selecting it and adding it to cart. It does not cost anything as your membership is covered by your tuition.

Step 2.2: It will prompt you to sign the SRC Waiver.



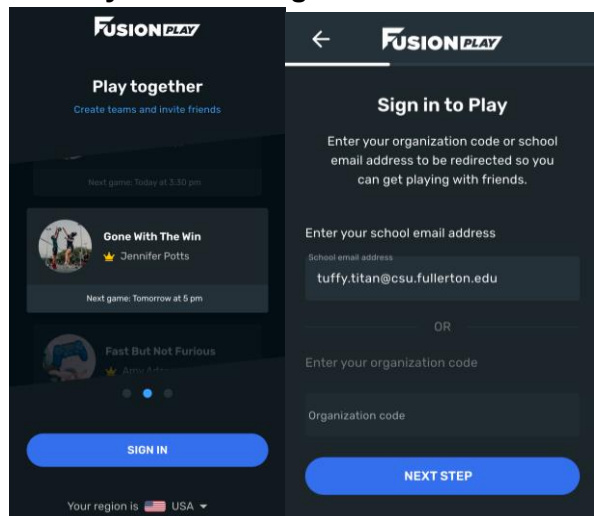
SECOND: Purchase your Intramural League Pass

Step 3: You can then select Intramural League Pass on the Fusion Go app or Titan Recreation Website. Pay for the one-time, \$20 Intramural League Pass. **You will not be able to create or join a team until you have paid.**

THIRD: Create or Join an Intramural Team

Step 4: Create a Fusion Play account if one is not already created. (If you already have one, skip to step 3)

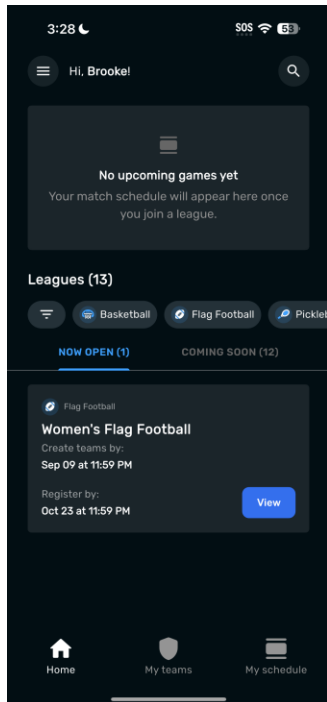
Step 4.1: Visit [HERE](#) or download the Fusion Play app and log in. ***Please use your CSUF login credentials.**



Step 4.2: Once logged in, it will prompt you to add an emergency contact. This is mandatory and it will not allow you to proceed without it.

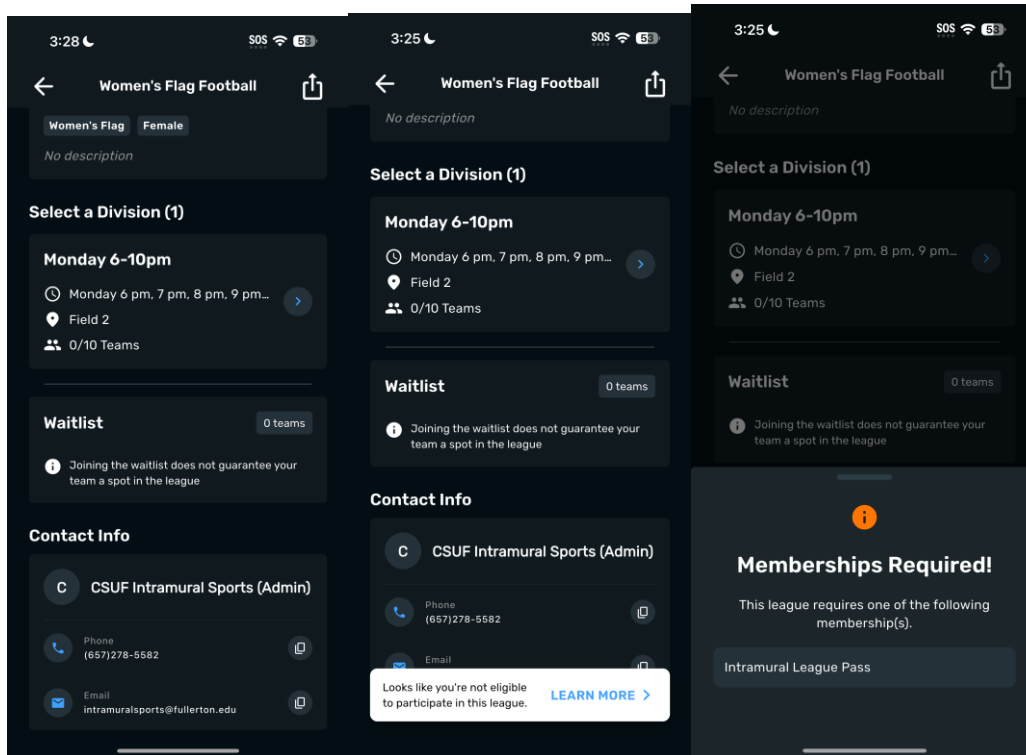
Step 4.3: It will prompt you to add basic information like gender, date of birth, contact information etc. This is to allow you to be able to join the correct teams and leagues, and also be notified of upcoming games and times.

Step 5: Click “NOW OPEN” on the front home page. Here you can filter by leagues and divisions.



Step 6: Scroll down and click your desired league (all-rec basketball, men’s soccer, etc). Once you have clicked on your desired league, it will bring you a page with the division. Please click on the division day.

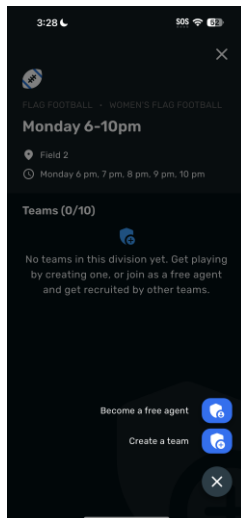
*If you have not paid, it will pop up with a banner stating you are not eligible and need to purchase an Intramural League Pass.



Step 7: Create/request to join a team.

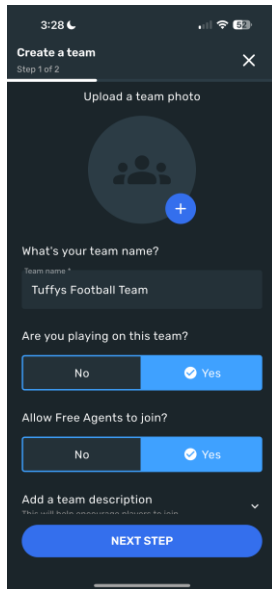
→ **If you are creating a team (captain):**

Step 7.1: Click blue circle with a white plus sign in the corner and select “Create a team.”



Step 7.2: It will then bring you to a page where you can create a team name. Additionally, adding a team logo is optional. Here you can also have the option to play on the team or just be the captain.

NOTE There is a setting under options titled “looking for free agents”. This allows people searching for a team to know that you are looking for players. **Free agents will be able to request to join your team, with the approval of the team captain.**

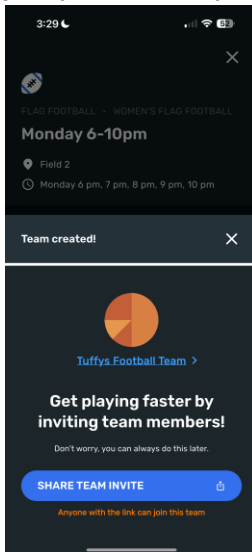

The California State University, Fullerton (CSUF), Intramural Sports Program is funded by Titan Student Union fees. Intramural Sports is a comprehensive program of recreational activities open to all currently enrolled CSUF students, faculty and staff members, registered alumni (paid member of alumni association), and Student Recreation Center membership holders. Leagues and tournaments are scheduled throughout the academic year. The Intramural Sports Program is committed to providing all CSUF students the opportunity to participate, and it encourages individuals, clubs, and university-recognized organizations to join in the fun.

Titan Recreation offers men's, women's, and mixed-gender leagues for basketball, flag football, ~~soocer, coftball, and~~ volleyball

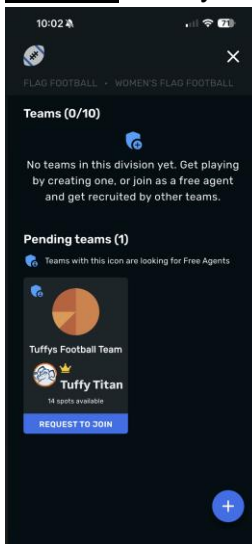
Step 7.4: Your team is now created. Your team will remain on the waitlist until you receive the minimum members required to play that sport. You can now invite people to join your team by sharing a team invite.



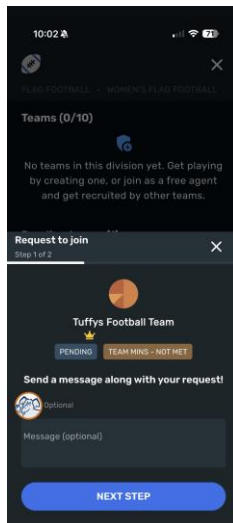
→ **If you are joining a team:**

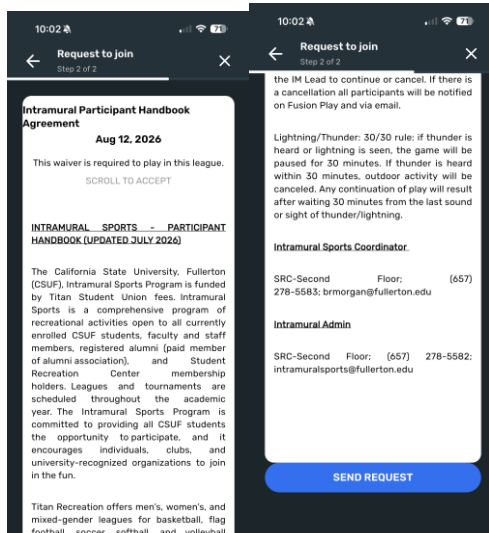
Step 7.1: Find your desired team and click “request to join”



Step 7.2: Once you request, click next step.



Step 7.3: Sign the waiver. If you choose not to agree, it will not let you join a team.

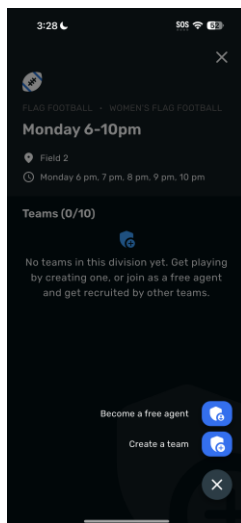


Step 7.4: You will be pending until the captain of the team chooses to accept you.

→ **If you are becoming a free agent:**

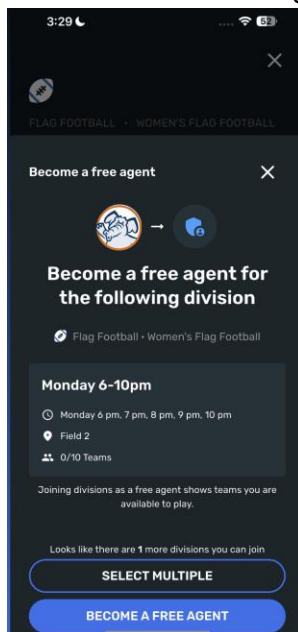

Step 7.1: Click blue circle with a white plus sign in the corner and select "Become a free agent"

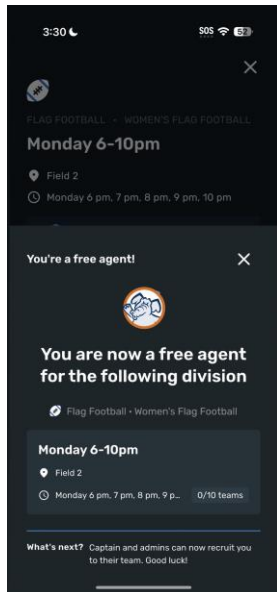


Step 7.2: Sign the waiver. If you choose not to agree, it will not let you join a team.

Step 7.3: Once waiver is signed, it will ask you to confirm what leagues and division you would like to become a free agent for.



Step 7.4: Captains and admins can now recruit you to their team. You will be notified when this occurs.
