DRDP Measure: Social and Emotional Understanding

Age Group: Toddler and Preschool

Felt Emotion Faces

Supplies needed:

Assorted colors of felt-

Cut in large circles for faces

Cut in assorted shapes for eyes

Cut crescent shapes for mouth

Cut shapes for teeth

Procedure

Arrange felt pieces on the table and let the child create faces. They can interpret how the faces are feeling.

In reference to DRDP measures the child can communicate ideas about why one has a feeling or what will happen as a result of a feeling.

The children are very creative and the felt allows the child to make many variations of expressions!
