#### ***Finger plays are important and delightful early learning tools:***

Children love their rhythm, rhyme, and repetition. This not only gives them a sense of security, but contributes to phonological awareness.

They are usually easy to learn. This gives children a sense of accomplishment and builds self-esteem.

Finger plays are terrific tools for introducing new vocabulary and providing building blocks to literacy.

They help strengthen fine motor skills and develop eye/hand coordination preparing fingers to write and draw!

Finger plays can be done with or without puppets. Puppets, however, raise the level of engagement and comprehension.
