



**Resolution to Appoint Camp Titan 2016 Co-Directors**

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4 Whereas the Board of Directors of the Associated Students, California State University, Fullerton,  
5 Incorporated is elected to represent the student body of California State University, Fullerton.

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7 Whereas this same Board of Directors has authority to allocate the associated student body fee and  
8 the campus union fee and subsequently to create programs and services in order to serve and support  
9 the student body of California State University, Fullerton. Additionally, the Board of Directors has the  
10 responsibility to ratify students appointed to leadership positions, which receive student leader  
11 financial awards.

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13 Whereas, in 1969, a group of students from the, then, California State College Fullerton decided that  
14 they wanted to give back to their community.

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16 And, whereas, this group wanted to provide a summer camp experience for children who normally  
17 would not have the opportunity to do so. So the idea of *Camp Titan* was born. These students, who  
18 were not only fraternity and sorority leaders but leaders in the Associated Students, took  
19 approximately one hundred underprivileged children from Orange County to Camp Ta Ta Pochon for a  
20 one week camping experience. No fees were charged to the campers that year and none have been  
21 since.

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23 Whereas, forty-six years later, *Camp Titan of the Associated Students, California State University,*  
24 *Fullerton, Inc.* continues to provide a free summer camp experience for approximately one hundred  
25 thirty underprivileged seven to fourteen year olds from Orange County. And, since 2000, the summer  
26 home of Camp Titan has been Camp Oakes located in Big Bear, where each year, some sixty students  
27 from Cal State Fullerton devote over 200 hours of their time, with no remuneration, to planning and  
28 implementing the camp.

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30 Whereas, each year, two students are selected by the director of ASI Leader & Program Development  
31 through an application and interview process to serve as the student co-directors for the up-coming  
32 camp season. These students work conjointly with the staff of ASI Leader & Program Development in  
33 the planning and implementation of Camp Titan.

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35 Whereas, Karin Lee has been part of Camp Titan as a counselor and a staff member since 2013. During  
36 her tenure, she has exhibited great leadership and connection with the campers and her fellow  
37 counselors.

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39 Whereas, Taylor Scherer has been part of Camp Titan since 2014 as a counselor and a staff member.  
40 During her time with camp, she has exhibited great leadership and insight into the running of Camp  
41 Titan.


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
Affirming that Karin Lee and Taylor Scherer meet all eligibility requirements to serve as Camp Titan co-directors.


Therefore be it resolved that Karin Lee and Taylor Scherer be ratified as Camp Titan Co-Directors for the term starting September 1, 2015 and ending July 31, 2016 with all the rights, responsibilities, student leader awards and privileges associated with the positions.

Further be it resolved that this resolution be distributed to the director and staff of ASI Leader & Program Development so that they may train, support and encourage the development of Ms. Lee and Ms. Scherer as students and as leaders, and to implement the necessary protocols to provide for student leader financial awards for Ms. Lee and Ms. Scherer.
